#### A MESSAGE FROM TEAM (M)PEACH

Oklahoma State Superintendent Ryan Walters has proven to be a clear and present danger to the health and welfare of Oklahoma's public schools. Not only has he repeatedly demonstrated gross incompetence in his official capacity, his administration regularly and unabashedly promotes policies and rhetoric that equate to willful neglect of duty, and he is under intense scrutiny for multiple violations of federal and state law.

Recently, his incendiary rhetoric has increased in volume and vitriol. His highly controversial misinformation about Tulsa Public Schools has thrown our state's largest school district into complete chaos. An altered TikTok video posted late August has inspired school bomb threats statewide and placed a death threat target on the back of a celebrated Oklahoma school librarian. Walters irresponsibly retweeted this video on his official state account and has refused to remove his tweet. By participating in this unprofessional online behavior, he has contributed to the threats of danger now being leveled upon Oklahoma's children and their school communities. The threats have now moved beyond Union Public Schools.

Walters' incompetence, willful neglect of duty, and potential criminal activity are impeachable offenses per the Oklahoma Constitution. The statute states does NOT have to be convicted of a crime in order to be impeached, although we are hopeful criminal charges are on the near horizon. At this juncture, the future welfare of Oklahoma's public school children rests squarely on the shoulders of the Republican Leadership of the Oklahoma Legislature. The longer this is allowed to go on, the more difficult it will be for Oklahoma's public schools to recover long term.

Thousands of Oklahomans have registered to join our grassroots movement, looking to identify ways they can help move the impeachment process along. This Action Packet is designed to give multiple options of ways you can help. This is a marathon. We cannot accomplish this without every concerned Oklahoman rolling up their sleeves to get to work. ### MEET WITH YOUR LEGISLATORS



THE SINGLE MOST IMPACTFUL WAY TO INFLUENCE THE RYAN WALTERS IMPEACHMENT PROCESS IS TO MEET WITH YOUR SENATOR AND HOUSE REPRESENTATIVE FACE-TO-FACE IN YOUR HOME DISTRICT! ALL ADVOCATES NEED TO DO THIS AS SOON AS POSSIBLE!

Call AND email your local legislators. Set a time to sit down to discuss how they plan to hold Ryan Walters accountable for the damage he is inflicting on our school funding, our teacher workforce, and the well-being of our children. IF YOU DO NOT KNOW WHO YOUR LEGISLATORS ARE OR HOW TO CONTACT THEM, email us at info@impeachwalters.com for help.

If you are unable to secure a face-to-face meeting, call and/or email them consistently. CALLS ARE BEST. If you are also emailing, make sure you include "constituent contact request" in your email subject. Be perisistent, be professional, and keep it up!

BONUS POINTS = grab 2-3 family members, friends, or neighbors to come with you!

DOUBLE BONUS POINTS = bring attendees from more than 1 political party! A cross-partisan approach is the most impactful meeting of all.

TRIPLE BONUS POINTS = reach out to 5 key community leaders in your town and ask them to set meetings also - legislators need to hear from constituents AND influential community leaders.

- Come prepared with our downloadable talking points/conversation guide and Walters' list of offenses.
- Ask for action to move towards impeachment.
- After your meeting, visit https://forms.gle/NbUANTs4nDDjiYPJ9 to submit your follow-up
  information to our legislative team! It is crucial for this call-to-action that you return here to let us
  know how your legislators responded. This allows us to track each legislative district and adjust
  accordingly.




### BECOME A COMMUNITY ORGANIZER

### WRITE A LETTER TO YOUR LOCAL PAPER



Writing a letter to your local newspaper editor is a great way to share your opinion while influencing your community to take action. We have a particulary high need for letters to smaller local/rural newspapers. Here's a step-by-step guide on how to write an effective letter to the editor:

- 1. Research the Guidelines: Before you start writing, visit the newspaper's website and look for guidelines on submitting letters to the editor. These guidelines will provide information on word limits, submission methods, and any specific formatting requirements. Adhering to these guidelines will increase the likelihood of your letter being published. Your local paper may not allow opinion letters about a specific politician. Find that out beforehand. If they don't, then ask if you can submit a more generalized letter about the perilous state our public schools are facing.
- 2. Keep It Concise: Letters to the editor are usually short, ranging from 150 to 300 words. Be concise and focused on a single point to ensure your message is clear and impactful. If your letter is too long, it might be edited for length or rejected.
- 4. Introduce Yourself: Begin your letter with a brief introduction that includes your name, your connection to the community (if relevant), and any credentials that lend credibility to your opinion.
- 5. State Your Opinion: Clearly state your opinion or perspective on the dangers of Ryan Walters staying in office. Be specific. Use straightforward language and avoid jargon to ensure your message is easily understood by a broad audience.
- 6. Provide Supporting Points: Offer concise and compelling arguments or evidence to support your opinion. Use facts, statistics, anecdotes, or personal experiences to strengthen your case. Be respectful and avoid making baseless claims.
- 7. Call to Action or Conclusion: End your letter with a clear call to action or a conclusion that reinforces your main point. Whether it's urging readers to get involved, advocating for a specific solution, or simply reiterating the importance of the issue, leave your readers with something to think about.

- 8. Proofread and Edit: Take the time to proofread your letter for grammar, spelling, and clarity. A well-written and error-free letter is more likely to be taken seriously by the newspaper's editors.
- 9. Submit Your Letter: Follow the submission guidelines provided by the newspaper to send in your letter. This could involve sending an email, using an online submission form, or mailing a physical letter. Make sure to include your contact information in case the editors need to reach you for verification.
- 10. Follow Up: If your letter is published, keep an eye on the newspaper to see if it appears. You might also receive responses from readers, which can lead to further discussions.

Remember that newspapers receive many letters and might not be able to publish them all. Even if your letter isn't published, the act of writing can still contribute to the public discourse and engage with your local community.

- If you have yet to register in our alert system, take a moment to do so. In the registration form, you are given the option of ways to volunteer. Make sure you check the box that says "Speak With Media". You can register at https://www.impeachwalters.com/alerts. Also make sure if you volunteer for media, that you also let us know your political affiliation. There is a need right now for media to hear from Republican voices, so this will help us identify that.
- In a few weeks, we will begin sharing our media pool information with state and national media
  outlets. The list will be sorted by community/area and by your role in the community (parent,
  business owner, etc.) The media may or may not contact you, but this will provide them with a
  solid list of contacts that are willing to speak with them. If you happen to score an interview and

#### SUBMIT BLOG CONTENT

SEND US CONTENT FOR OUR BLOG - selected posts will be uploaded to our website and shared via our social media channels. Your content will also included in a weekly email to legislators with stories from around the state regarding why they should remove Ryan Walters from office.

- Email blog submissions to us at info@impeachwalters.com. Include your name, hometown, and role (parent, educator, concerned citizen, etc.). Attach a recent photo, close-up/headshot preferred.
- Keep written content to 1000 words max.
- Your audience consists of the members of the Oklahoma Legislature this is who you are writing to. Your job is to share with them why you feel they should impeach Ryan Walters.
- Write Compelling Headlines: Craft a headline that is attention-grabbing and clearly reflects the content of your blog post. A strong headline can significantly impact whether readers choose to engage with your content.
- Provide Value and Solutions: Ensure your content addresses your readers' needs or challenges and provides actionable solutions or insights. High-quality content should leave readers feeling informed, empowered, or inspired.
- Edit and Proofread: After writing your blog post, take the time to edit and proofread it for grammar, spelling, punctuation, and clarity. Mistakes can diminish the credibility of your content, so ensure it is error-free.
- Add Internal and External Links: Incorporate relevant internal links to other posts on your blog
  and external links to reputable sources that support your claims. This helps establish your blog
  as a credible resource and enhances the user experience.
- Include a Compelling Conclusion: Wrap up your blog post with a concise conclusion that summarizes your main points and reinforces the key takeaways. End with a call to action for Ryan Walters to be impeached by the Oklahoma Legislature.
